

Why to participate?

The COST - Training school will enable the participants to meet the colleagues from European institutions who provide intensive training on new and emerging end-of-use of packaging solutions, and thus broaden their knowledge, learn about new approaches, discuss with experts and share the experiences.

With your participation, we hope that the Training school will result in new ideas and creative energy for the future scientific exchanges as well as in fruitful joint projects and actions in long term planing.

Who should participate?

The invited trainees should preferably be young researchers, early stage researchers, PhD students, but also all other researchers interested in the topic.

What does the program of the Training school look like?

The Training school is a four day activity. The program includes courses by the eminent experts:

- Arie Hooimeijer: *Slim and Smart Supply Chains: Paper and board, Solid board*. KCPK, The Netherlands

The training school program also includes the “speed dating” concept of “everybody meeting everybody”, short presentations of the research achievements by trainees, group work, discussions and other.

How to apply? Is there a deadline for application? Is there a “numerus clausus”?

The number of trainees is limited by the COST Action FP 1003 financial capacities to ca 30 trainees.

What are the related costs?

For the trainees from the COST Action FP 1003 member countries (please, check at http://www.cost.esf.org/domains_actions/fps/Actions/FP1003?parties) the cost of the Training school is 40 Euro, which will be reimbursed to the trainees together with the travel and accommodation expenses according to the COST reimbursement rules.

For the trainees from other countries, the Training school fee is 60 Euro; travel and accommodation expenses are on your own.

What kind of input is expected from the trainees?

The trainees are expected to give a short presentation (10 – 15 min) about their research and achievements. The Proceedings will be published. Please follow further instructions.
