

How to get to the event:

By Metro: Nearest metro station is Schuman on lines 1 & 5.

By Train: After arriving at Gare du Midi follow the white M signs to the Metro. Take lines 2 & 6 towards Simonis (Elisabeth) to Art-Loi station. From there change to lines 1 & 5 towards Stockel or Hermann-Debroux, alighting at Schuman.

From the Airport

By bus: Follow the bus signs and catch the N° 12 or 21 bus to Schuman Roundabout. See <http://www.stib.be/> for times.

By train: Follow the signs to the train station and catch the train to the Central Station ('Gare Centrale'). Then catch the metro four stops to Schuman, line 1 & 5, direction Herman Debroux or Stockel. See www.b-rail.be/ for times.
